Dear Parents and Guardians ,  
Time flies and before you know it, we are in Term 2.

This can be a 'challenging ' term as our students will be having their first Semestral Examination. Nevertheless, let us not be bogged down with results. What should be closest to our minds is instilling the love for learning in our students.

To achieve that , the staff of KS were engaged in training during the March holidays , to upgrade our skills so that real and meaningful learning takes place in the classrooms.

One of the approaches that the teachers have explored is the use of Big Story Books for reading together, learning about values and role-playing. Shared-book is part of an approach called STELLAR . It stands for **ST**راتيجيات for **E**nglish **L**anguage **L**earning and **R**eadng. Thus far, the teachers who have used the approach have found that our students love the stories that they read and they enjoy dramatizing the stories. We will continue to explore ways of leveraging STELLAR to develop our students to be confident and effective users of the English language. KS has also revisited the way we teach Numeracy and Science. This , we will share in future editions of the KS Connect.

## *2017 Completed Events in*

### *Term 1*

#### **Satellite Partnership with Bedok View Secondary School**

School leaders from APSN Katong School (KS) and Bedok View Secondary School (BVSS) and MOE Psychological Branch met up on 14 February to endorse the year-long programme drawn up by both schools for Satellite Partnership 2018. The satellite partnership received an enthusiastic start in 2018 when Katong School (KS) and Bedok View Secondary School (BVSS) started off the tooth-brushing programme for Primary 1 to 3 students on 5 February. BVSS provided the toothbrush kit for the students. The tooth-brushing buddy programme aimed to create awareness of dental hygiene and proper tooth-brushing techniques. Admirably, both buddies and our students related well with one another with use of a graphical chart that depicted clearly what each step of tooth-brushing entailed. During the activity, it was evident that both buddy and learner remained fully engaged to maximise learning outcomes. During another occasion to mark Total Defence Day on 14 February 2018, BVSS NCC students performed gun drills for KS primary students. The students were very excited and watched the high precision and well-coordinated postures with amazement as they enjoyed each movement made by the NCC students.

## **Breakfast @ KS —27 January**

KS had its first school-home networking session for 2018 on Saturday, 27 January. School leaders, HODs and relevant staff turned up to support the event which was held from 8.30am to 12.00pm for parents/ caregivers of both primary and secondary school students. A total of 36 parents and 20 students participated in the event. Group discussions revolved around SPED living outcomes related to food preparation, personal grooming, independent travelling, engaging in leisure activities and managing personal finance. The discussions proved beneficial as parents too provided inputs to strategies on how to teach and apply the skills to their children, both at home and in the community.

While parents attended the session, the children were engaged through craft work and a Zumba session conducted by a qualified vendor. A satisfaction survey conducted with the participants showed that 100 % of parents were satisfied with the event and activities organized for their family. They also found the group discussions on SPED living outcomes to be very beneficial. Feedback from the parents were shared with the KS community (parents and staff), and uploaded in the KS public website, as well as SharePoint. The feedback would also be weaved into the curriculum to nurture the desired living skills in our students.
