We also share with you three key events in Term 2 -International Friendship Day, Hari Raya celebrations and a **Community Inclusion** Partnership with Anglican High School.


We look forward to your attendance in our Parents' Network Webinars once a month and having your continued support for us to provide memorable experiences and bring out the best in our students, your children/wards.
