SCHOOL-HOME COLLABORATION

4 WAYS TO NURTURE INTEGRITY IN OUR STUDENTS IN SCHOOL AND AT HOME

Be a Role Model and Share Values

Students learn by watching the adults around them. It is crucial to demonstrate integrity in our own words and actions, like following rules or keeping promises.

Encourage Honesty and Openness

Make telling the truth a core value at home. Encourage students to be open about their mistakes. Reward honest behaviour with positive reinforcement.

Encourage Listening to The "Inner Voice"

Help students develop their
"inner voice" by teaching
them to pause, reflect and
consider how a situation
feels to them. If something
feels wrong or
uncomfortable, it might be a
sign to stop and think.

Use Stories and Scenarios

Share simple stories with moral lessons or discuss hypothetical "What If?" scenarios to help students differentiate right from wrong, understand ethical dilemmas and learn to make thoughtful, honest choices.




